Dear Orchid Friends and Customers,

Well summer has arrived here on the Garden Route at long last! Just in time for the holiday makers to declare it was a good season. We locals, however, are delighted when they leave and peace is once more restored to our roads and towns. I am sure a lot of money was made, especially when I saw the number of people outside places like the strawberry farm in Geelhoutboom – quite amazing!

This year I seem to be on top of things at the nursery and most of the potting is finished and I can concentrate on watering and feeding for the remaining summer months. I have changed things a bit at the nursery and removed a section of 60% shadecloth under the polycarbonate, giving me an area where I can grow orchids which need higher light. I will also be doing some experiments with potting mediums.

Good news is that my bark supplier from Mpumalanga is going to be delivering to nearby Waboomskraal again, so my fine bark will be delivered in the next few weeks. My seedling mix is very popular and I got quite concerned last year when I thought I could no longer get quality bark. Do remember that I am happy to send it by courier, I will just have to calculate the weight and volume to give you exact courier costs.

Some other news is that I have been appointed as a Director of the South African Orchid Council. The 4 Societies under my wing are all in the Western Cape:- Orchid Soc. Of S Cape, Walker Bay Society, Cape Orchid Society and the Tygerberg Orchid Society. I have already visited the Cape Orchid Society show held at Lourensford in Somerset West and it was a resounding success. They have an autumn show to be held at the Uitsig Wine Estate in Constantia during April. Our own society will have its yearly show in September as per usual. There is also a possibility that the National show will be held in the Western Cape in 2027 – watch this space for more details!

I have added more detail and photos to the complex Paphiopedilums in the list and all are looking good and rooted and ready for their new homes. All are blooming size for 2025. The 2024 consignment are all potted and are a good size. A further paphiopedilum consignment has arrived from the Far East so a few species are added to the list.

I am still only open to the public on a Wednesday morning from 10am – 1pm, otherwise by appointment. Address is 34 Napier Str, Blanco, George.

A/o	<p><i>Epidendrum quitensium</i> Easy growing floriferous reedstem Epi with 18" canes with closely spaced upward pointing leathery leaves, inflorescences as tall as 3' produce a circular head of continuously blooming solid purple flowers. 12.5cm pots.</p>		250.00

A/o	<p><i>Epidendrum xanthinum</i> Found in Colombia and Brazil as a large sized, cool to cold growing terrestrial reedstem orchid at elevations of 1500 to 2200 meters. 12cm pots.</p>		175.00
O/o	<p><i>Laelia anceps</i> New group of blooming sized Laelia anceps. Various shades of lavender. Good shape and well marked lips.</p>		350.00

E27	<p><i>Masdevallia herradurae</i> Found in Colombia and Ecuador where it grows on mossy trees at about 500m. It is a mini-miniature sized, cool growing epiphyte. Flowers smells of stale coconut and are held at or below leaf height. 8cm pots.</p>		100.00
O/o	<p><i>Maxillaria sophronitis</i> Found in Venezuela and NE Colombia as a dwarf sized, mat forming, cool to warm growing species that blooms in early winter with a single flowered orange/red inflorescence. 9cm pots.</p>		125.00
O/o	<p><i>Oncidium flexuosum</i> Found in South America including Brazil and Argentina. Has a tall, many flowered inflorescence with tiny yellow flowers. Makes a nice specimen plant. 14cm Airpots.</p>		150.00
O/o	<p><i>Oncidium sphacelatum</i> Delightful, easy to grow species which blooms in mid-summer with long spikes and many yellow/brown blooms. 15cm pots. Some larger ones available in Airpots at R300.00</p>		150.00

O/o	<p><i>Platystele consobrina</i> This is an epiphytic orchid primarily from Colombia. It grows in a wet tropical biome. It blooms in the spring with many 7 mm wide flowers. I have known mine to bloom twice a year. 7cm pots.</p>		100.00
TSG/	<p><i>Sedirea japonica</i> Miniature growing species with a Phalaenopsis-like leaf habit. The flowers have a strong citrus scent. Flower spikes carry up to 8 ivory flowers barred and spotted with fuchsia in spring.</p>		395.00
O/o	<p><i>Stanhopea dodsoniana</i> The native range of this species is Central & S Mexico to Honduras. It is a pseudobulbous epiphyte and grows primarily in the seasonally dry tropical biome. Growing in moss balls.</p>		395.00
O/o	<p><i>Stanhopea occulata</i> Native to South and Central America, this species blooms with multiple flowers from each spike. Like most Stanhopea, these are fragrant as well! Moss balls.</p>		350.00


